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Your child's teacher will provide a daily plan as per timetable shown below. and planning sheet. Teacher direct communication time is clearly specified. This is when teachers will be live on line to interact with learners. Teacher contact will be focused on learner engagement. Teachers will not have the capacity to correct and return work but will shout out to good examples of completed tasks.



There will be 3 levels of challenge set for tasks - 'Mild', 'Medium' and 'Spicy' or challenge 1, challenge 2, challenge 3...take your pick or do all 3.

Across the week there will be at least one daily opportunity for Live login (health allowing). There may be some teething troubles so please bear with us! You can join the Lennoxtown Primary School Team for these events.
